

**Proposed Bylaws Amendment Regarding Selection of Members  
of the Resolutions Committee, 2006**

Section 10 of the Bylaws of the National Lawyers Guild shall be amended as follows:

**"SECTION 10 - ~~PERMANENT~~ RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE**

A ~~Permanent~~ Resolutions Committee is established whose purposes include: drafting or encouraging the drafting of resolutions which are presented at national meetings; functioning as a subcommittee of the Podium Committee at national meetings; reviewing all resolutions which are presented to that meeting. The Committee may also work with the National Executive Committee if resolutions are presented to that body. The members of the Resolutions Committee shall be ~~recommended~~ *selected* by the National Executive Committee ~~to the Convention~~. ~~Additional nominations may be offered before the members of the Resolutions Committee are ratified and approved by the Convention.~~ All members of this Committee shall serve for a term from the convention at which they are selected until the next convention."

Purpose: To remove the requirement that members of the Resolutions Committee be ratified at a plenary session at the convention and to change the name from "Permanent Resolutions Committee" to "Resolutions Committee".
