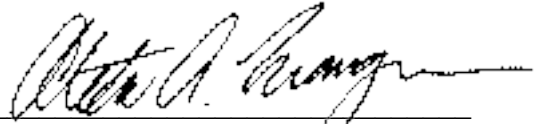
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

The Plaintiffs' Motion For Temporary Restraining Order (Docket No. 9) was heard on October 31, 2011. Counsel for all parties appeared at the hearing. For the reasons expressed on the record at the hearing, and by agreement of the defendants, it is hereby **ORDERED** that a temporary restraining order hereby **ISSUES**, temporarily restraining the defendants from enforcing the "Legislative Plaza, War Memorial Courtyard and Capitol Grounds Use Policy" issued by the Tennessee Department of General Services on October 27, 2011 (Docket No. 1-3) against the plaintiffs or any other individuals, pending further order of the court. By agreement, this Temporary Restraining Order will not require the posting of security by the plaintiffs and shall extend for a period of twenty-one (21) days. This Temporary Restraining Order does not prevent state and local officials from enforcing valid criminal and civil laws.

A hearing on converting the Temporary Restraining Order issued herein to a preliminary injunction shall be held on Monday, November 21, 2011, at 10:30 a.m.

It is so **ORDERED**.
