

We, the National Lawyers Guild at Rutgers Law-Newark, stand in uncompromising solidarity with the Palestinian people in their national liberation struggle as they continue to resist Zionist colonization, illegal military occupation, and Israeli apartheid.

It is impossible to comprehend the current moment outside of Israel's 75 year colonization of

Palestinian land. Israel's official policy of maximum land with minimum Palestinians¹ has besieged the Palestinians of Gaza, controlling their food, air, land, sea, and trade.² For the Palestinians in the West Bank, this political project has expanded illegal Israeli settlements, systematically dispossessed Palestinians of their land, segregated them as second-class non-citizens in a racist apartheid system, and terrorized them with settler violence.³

Colonial violence invariably begets resistance,⁴ something Israeli citizens⁵ and lawmakers have long recognized.⁶ Earlier this month, in response to this 75 year crime, Palestinian resistance factions launched an attack.⁷ *There is no equivalence – moral or otherwise – between Israel's 75 years of colonial violence and the resistance that it has engendered.* The only just response to loss of life is to confront its root cause.

We unequivocally condemn any statement which equates the response of the oppressed to the violence of the oppressor. When Palestinians demanded their civil rights from the Israeli government, over 65 laws that discriminate against Palestinians were upheld by the Israeli Supreme Court.⁸ When Palestinians took Israel to the International Criminal Court for the crime of apartheid, the US sanctioned the ICC officials who took their case.⁹ When Palestinians in diaspora sought to enact their civic rights to boycott Israel through the BDS movement, they were criminalized and maligned as anti-Jewish.¹⁰ When Palestinians engaged in non-violent civil disobedience during the

2018 Great March of Return in Gaza, they were shot and killed en masse.¹¹ And finally, when Palestinians took up arms in resistance against one of the greatest military powers in the world,¹² they became terrorists.

The Palestinian people have exercised every strategy in their pursuit of liberation and have had every strategy condemned. It is as though no form of resistance is acceptable for Palestinians, and what is requested of them is that they die silently, allowing themselves to be erased. Palestinians, as a dispossessed and colonized people, have every right¹³ to stand up against a nuclear power¹⁴ which has erased them from their land and subjugated them under Zionist colonization. <u>The right to resist</u> *is a moral and legal right of all oppressed people*.

We condemn the one-sided and racist emails from administrators and classmates alike which reinvigorate the War on Terror narrative, inflaming anti-Muslim racism, further exposing our Arab and Muslim neighbors to harm, and dehumanizing Palestinians to normalize their genocide.¹⁵ Depictions of Palestinians as savage, barbaric, "human animals,"¹⁶ or sickening comparisons to Nazis work to remove Palestinians from their humanity. *If Palestinians are no longer human, are they still civilians?*

In recent days, Israel has disproportionately targeted¹⁷ civilian infrastructure¹⁸ - homes,¹⁹ colleges,²⁰ mosques, evacuation caravans, and hospitals, in clear contravention of international law.²¹ Dehumanizing, racist, anti-Muslim rhetoric and inflammatory, unsubstantiated stories have

As Americans whose government supports the genocide in military funding, diplomatic support, and arms, it is our responsibility to speak out.²³ We call on all law students of conscience²⁴ to echo the calls of Palestinian civil society for an <u>urgent cease fire</u> and to call on Israel to end its occupation and colonization of all lands, recognize the fundamental rights of the Palestinian citizens of Israel to full equality, and uphold the Palestinian right of return²⁵ to their homes.
